Area Focus: Camden Passage, N1

WHY? This rabbit warren of streets tucked away behind Upper St, near Angel Tube station, is one of North London's most charming spots to shop, eat, drink and stroll WHEN? Wed and Sat daytimes for the smaller antiques shops, vintage shops and stalls, and every day and into the evening for everything else.



EXCELLENT VINTAGE

This area is famous for its antiques shops and stalls, which specialise in vintage clothing and accessories, some from the 19th century. **Annie's Vintage Costume** and Textiles, one of the larger shops, is a Camden Passage institution and claims John Galliano among its fans (12 Camden Passage. **2** 020 7359 0796. Second anniesvintageclothing.co.uk). Stroll through Pierrepoint Arcade on Wed and Sat and squeeze into its petite, lovely shops.



SILVER SCREEN

A two-minute walk north brings you to **The Screen on the Green**, a 300-seat cinema screening independent and mainstream films. The charming building dates from 1911 and oddly enough, played host to an early gig by the punk band the Sex Pistols in 1976, just after the release of their iconic hit, *Anarchy in the UK*. It's open daily.
